

5 CLASSES OF FIRE



Ordinary combustibles such as wood, paper, cloth, rubber and some plastic.

 **Extinguish:** Remove heat, fuel or oxygen. Both foam fire extinguishers and powder fire extinguishers




Flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline, kerosene, paint, paint thinners and propane.

 **Extinguish:** Do NOT use water to extinguish fire. Use CO2 fire extinguisher




Electrical equipment, such as appliances, switches, panel boxes and power tools.

 **Extinguish:** Do not use xxxxxxxxxxxx




Combustible metals, such as magnesium, titanium, potassium and sodium.

 **Extinguish:** Do not use xxxxxxxxxxxx



Cooking fats or oils such as any animal or vegetable based fats or oils.

 **Extinguish:** Do not use xxxxxxxxxxxx
