5 CLASSES OF FIRE





Ordinary combustibles such as wood, paper, cloth, rubber and some plastic.

Extinguish: Remove heat, fuel or oxygen. Both foam fire extinguishers and powder fire extinguishers



Combustible metals, such as magnesium, titanium, potassium and sodium.






Flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline, kerosene, paint, paint thinners and propane.

Extinguish: Do NOT use water to extinguish fire.
Use CO2 fire extinguisher



Cooking fats or oils such as any animal or vegetable based fats or oils.





Electrical equipment, such as appliances, switches, panel boxes and power tools.
